

## Genre Book Projects

This page describes the projects that should be completed for each book read.

Genre	Project
<b>Fiction</b>	
Mystery (October)	Create a flow map of important events or a comic strip to summarize the story.
Fantasy (November)	Describe 3 places in the book that make it a fantasy (at least two sentences each). Rank them in order from least real to most real and explain.
Historical Fiction (January)	Create 6 questions about this book (who, what, where, why, why, and how) and answer them.
Realistic Fiction (February)	List three character traits that describe the main character. Give examples from the book that support your thinking.
<b>Non-Fiction</b>	
Biography (March)	What is there about this person's life that reminds you of your life? Write about it. - OR - Write three interview questions you would like to ask this person. Answer them how you think he or she would answer.
Poetry (April)	Turn a poem from your book into a story. This story must be at least two pages long.
Non-Fiction (May)	Create a list of five important facts and five interesting facts found in the book. Choose at least one from each list and explain why it is important or interesting.
